The successful candidate will hold a full-time Limited Term Academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor, or a Continuing Clinical Academic appointment at the rank of Associate Professor or Professor, depending upon experience and qualifications at the time of appointment. Candidates must hold an MD and be eligible for licensing in the Province of Ontario. Specialist certification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology through the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or equivalent is required. A formal fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility is required. Training and/or experience in research with an established track record of publications would be an asset. The successful candidate will also have a commitment to and demonstrated aptitude for teaching, and will be expected to teach at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels and to supervise Ob/Gyn resident trainees.
