

## RETIREMENT AND RESIGNATION

### Resignation

1. A Member may resign by giving three (3) months' notice in writing to the Chief Librarian or to the President of the University. A Member who is a full-time student in which case the child must be under the age of 25. A mentally or physically infirm child will continue to be eligible for coverage in accordance with the Benefits contract effective February 1, 2003 for the Faculty Retiree Group.
