<p><i>4.18.3.8 of B44 Code, Supplement 1-1992.</i></p> <p>If leaking is suspected on in-ground cylinders that have a protective plastic casing, the space between the casing and the cylinder must be blown out using compressed air.</p> <p>The contents will be collected to determine any leakage from the cylinder.</p> <p>4. Shut off the line valve.</p> <p>5. Leave the car off for 15 minutes and determine how much the car sinks.</p> <p>If there is further doubt as to the soundness of the cylinder, a *static test must be carried out.</p>
