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**EYEWASH AND EMERGENCY SHOWER TESTING**

- Eyewash stations in laboratories to be inspected/tested weekly by Laboratory personnel.
- Eyewash stations in corridors/general areas to be inspected/tested weekly by FM Building Services.
- Emergency showers to be inspected/tested monthly by FM Building Services.
- Emergency showers and eyewash stations in restricted areas, such as Power Plant and Mechanical Rooms, to be tested by FM Operations. Emergency showers to be tested monthly and eyewash stations to be tested weekly.
- All emergency showers and eyewash stations to be tested annually by the Plumbing shop.

**DEFINITIONS**
