LISTENING COMPREHENSION TESTS - 30 minutes (2x 5% = 10%)

~ There will be 2 Listening Comprehension Tests, each worth 5%. The Tests are administered in the Language Lab at the end of each term. The format will include a variety of comprehension exercises, some oral translation exercises and a dictation.

ORAL TEST - 10 minutes (5%)

~ An Oral Test given at the end of the second term. Each student will set up a 10-minute interview with the instructor, scheduled during regular class time. The Oral Test will consist of a reading of your Final
