

Eligible students must be currently enrolled in a philosophy course at the University of Western Ontario and must have a grade of 2 or higher in a main-campus philosophy course taken during the fall or winter term of the current academic year.

Instructors will be asked to nominate essays, but students can also nominate themselves if they have the endorsement of the instructor for whom the essay was written (i.e., their signature on this form).

The Chair of Philosophy will select the award recipient, who will receive \$750 and have their name entered into the annual award ceremony.

All submitted essays should have a cover page that includes the following information: student name, student number, email address, and full mailing address, and the number of the course for which the essay was written. All identifiers should be removed from the essay itself.

Nomination forms and essays are due April 15 and should be submitted to the Undergraduate Program Coordinator, Sarah Murdoch at [sarah.murdoch@uwo.ca](mailto:sarah.murdoch@uwo.ca) in PDF or DOC format.
