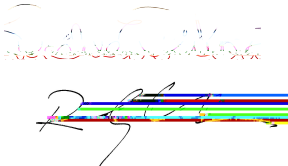

4. DEFINITIONS

Anonymized information: the information is irrevocably stripped of direct identifiers, a code is NOT kept to allow future re-linkage, and risk of re-identification of individuals from remaining indirect identifiers is low or very low.

Confidentiality: refers to the obligation of an individual or organization to safeguard entrusted information and includes the obligation to protect information from unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, loss or theft

De-identification: means to remove any information that identifies the individual or for which it is reasonably foreseeable in the circumstances that it could be utilized, either alone or with other information, to identify the individual.

Identifiable information: means information that may reasonably be expected to identify an individual,
