

- ! Assignment 1: Negative Message with positive emphasis (up to 1000 words) 20%
- ! Assignment 2: Proposal with visual (up to 1200 words) 25%
- ! Assignment 3: Formal Report with visual (1200-1400 words, excluding front and back matter) 40%
- ! Note: Each of Assignments 1, 2, and 3 includes a preliminary peer-review draft stage. In each week a peer-review session is scheduled, you must bring to class a copy (paper or electronic) of a preliminary draft of the assignment in question. This draft should be sufficiently complete (in my judgement allow you to obtain meaningful comment on it from one or more of your peers. I will ask you to show me your draft in class, during the peer-review session. Failure to attend class with a sufficiently complete draft and/or participate by reviewing at least one other student's draft will result in the earned mark for that assignment being reduced by 10%. For example, what would have been an earned mark of 78 for Assignment #3 will have a mark of 70 recorded. Note that this penalty will be applied in addition to any other applicable penalties (e.g., for late submission).
